The Course

Start & Finish in DeHaer Rd, opposite the entrance to the Wandi Community Hall & Equestrian Centre, The course is FIVE laps of the circuit: deHaer Rd–Wandi Dve–Lyon Rd(8.35km/lap)

Travelling from Perth, take the Rowley Rd exit from the Kwinana Freeway (approx 30min from The Narrows). The Start is about 7km from the Kwinana station on the Mandurah rail line or 10km from Cockburn Central.

Medal categories: All riders are eligible for their respective OPEN TITLES, Men and Women.

MASTERS riders: Men over 35 years, Women over 30 years - placing determined according to *Age Standards (2013 revision)*. We will also publish results according to 10-year age groupings.

Para-cyclists will be ranked according to their performances relative to their previous best speeds (as %)

- **All riders are assumed to have read and will have agreed to the disclaimer and conditions set out during the race entry procedure.**
- Approved helmets are compulsory (AS/NZ 2063)
- LATE STARTS will be penalised according to the lateness of reporting to the starter
The actual start time will be at the discretion of the starter (but not within 30sec of another rider). So if you have a mechanical problem, report to the starter before your scheduled start time.
- RESTARTS are permitted for mechanical mishaps in the first 300m.
- DRAFTING is not permitted (Drafting is as defined in the ATTA rules)
- FOLLOWING SUPPORT VEHICLES are NOT permitted.

Protests must be lodged in writing within 15 minutes of the arrival of the final rider.

IMPORTANT: the roads are NOT CLOSED and you must KEEP TO THE LEFT. If passing you must be within 1.5m of the rider being passed and return to the left-hand side of the road as soon as practicable. You are responsible for your own safety and for keeping on-course; marshals can only assist.

Riders failing to abide by race or road rules may be disqualified and race officials are not obliged to issue warnings. A mobile race referee will be on the course.

Entry Fees: \$30 (discounts for ATTA members and riders with personal transponders)
