<u>Hilly 6 Gidgegannup C – Race Report</u>

Riders were greeted by a fresh and blustery wind this morning in Gidgegannup, some even claimed it was a bit cool while warming up but that soon passed as they climbed the first hill. Well done to those who were able to manage the conditions riding a TT bike fitted with deep section aero wheels, some with discs. Only one PB, by Mick Brammer, confirmed the challenging nature of today's outing.

Fastest around the course was Lyndon Greeshaw, followed closely by Sean Ralph who established an impressive male road bike record. First female home was Kate Bonner, Jennifer Davis was a close second with Wanda Jansen Van Vuuren establishing a female road bike record. Richard Williams again demonstrated his determination, grinding his way around the course on his handcycle.

We had 2 junior females ride the course, a great training session as they prepare for the upcoming road nationals. Expect that climbing all those hills today will be beneficial.

Today was Tanya Birkbeck's 100th ride during an ATTA event, a great milestone to have realised.

The dappled morning light once again confirmed the importance of having a bright tail light fitted to your bike and why we recommend a front light as well. We even had feedback from a local who stopped at the finish line about how difficult it was to see riders on course without bright flashing lights on their bikes.

Teagan Sonego (assisted by John) managed the desk at the showgrounds. David Equid collated the entry lists, was starter and ran the timing systems. Sherief Khorshid looked after riders turning at the Reserve/Berry Rd corner, John and Mala Andrews handled the U-turn. Troy Wainwright was out early setting up the course and after everyone had left packing things away, unfortunately he had a DNF ride due to mechanical issues. Mouse provided his usual backup number crunching to validate the results and update the historical records.

We will be back at Chidlow on Sunday 21 April for the AusCycling U19 / Elite / Masters State ITT riding the Chidlow C course. There will also be a regular ATTA event held in conjunction with the Championships for those who prefer that option.
