Hopeland Pairs Race Report

When we asked last year for feedback on what members would like, one of the most popular responses was for more two up events. Unfortunately, this was not reflected in registrations for today's event. Perhaps the change in name from The Gents to the more appropriate The Pairs confused some people. Hopefully next year's event will be back to our usual numbers.

The twenty-seven brave souls who did ride were welcomed to Hopeland by some rather inclement weather, although thankfully the rain had passed by the time the first riders were on their way. The rain did however mean that the intermediate timing loop could not be set up, so there were no turn times today. And the flag at the finish line did suggest that the weather had a sting in its tail, with riders returning into a fairly brisk headwind. In spite of this, it was a day for several records, PBs and excellent rides.

First team home were Chris Roberts and Greg Rossiter but no new record this time for Chris. Four minutes later Campbell McDowell, on his 50th TT led Scotty across the line. Andrew Fitzgerald and Sean Ralph set a *Male-pairs-road* record, Marion Mundt and Lauren Humphries then establish the *Female-pairs-road* record while Lily and Ryan Suckling created a *Mixed-pairs-road* record (happy birthday Ryan). Jeremy Smith romped home with a Junior *Solo* record while Alex Vukovich and Matheos Venetis took over top spot but were just 9sec short of the existing *Mens* record set last year by Chris and Mike Freiberg. There were PBs for Matheos, Amanda, Greg and John Sonogo (possibly assisted by Teagan ensuring he arrived at today's event early). And credit to Troy Coulthard on his 250th ride with ATTA.
