For the first time 2024 welcomed the AusCycling Transplant ITT Championships. The winners were Jake Prince at U19, Aaron Lee elite male, and Kate Burton elite female.

The ATTA Good Friday TT witnessed some amazing times, with over half of the field recording faster than 40 kph. Even more amazing was that we had four course records. Sophia Sammons was good to her word of targeting Bella King's record set in 2014, taking 26 seconds of it. Sean Ralph beat his own road bike record, and Jeremy Smith set a new junior standard. Finally Jarred Anderson recovered from a puncture followed by a restart to take nine seconds of Matt Burton's previous record. In total there were 43 personal bests out there, and given the conditions I am sure many more came close to theirs. And lastly Steve Knight topped the standards placings.

Steve Oates again gave up his time to sort out start lists and to manage the timing and results, in between setting himself an impressive PB. As usual Mouse crunched numbers in the background managing the data we use. Stuart Murray looked after course set up and take down. Simone Wright had a very busy morning on the desk, as did Dugald Rogers on the bridge. Turi Innes-Manning and Isak looked after the residential area. John Healy was your starter, and his job was made straightforward by the excellent Walter Lundberg getting everybody to the start line so efficiently.
