Well that was pleasant; said nobody rolling over the finish line. Which makes the fact that we had three course records all the more remarkable. Well done to Jarrad, Findlay and Els (once again) for setting new male, junior male and female course records. Well done also to the three riders setting new personal bests. Possibly a reflection of the difficulty of the conditions.

Unfortunately, the cable connector into the decoder box failed, so we have no intermediate times splits. However, you can safely assume your time on the way out was faster than it was on the way home.

This morning we were happy to welcome back Wanda for the first time since she was attacked by some stray honky nuts loitering on the ground at Kings Park in January last year. A very impressive return.

Thankfully the Porsche drivers club caused nothing more than irritation with their erratic overtaking, although quite a few riders reported needing to make adjustments to stay safe.

David Equid has been a man of many tasks ensuring the success of today's event, including looking after Race Roster, the start list, timekeeping, results, and traffic management permissions. Troy Wainwright took care of course set up, and Colin Rose BWTM duties. Jane Higgins welcomed you at the desk, Tanya Birkbeck sent you off on your journey down Hopeland Road, to be greeted by Ian McRobbie at the turn some 15km later. Thank you everybody.

We are back again at Herne Hill next Sunday. Please remember that road rules will be strictly enforced, and that crossing solid white lines will result in disqualification. This is essential, primarily for rider safety. We do not ride on closed roads. Crossing solid white lines is also one of the largest causes of complaints we receive from local drivers, and has the potential for us to lose courses.
