This morning was our first collaboration event with West Coast Masters for some time, and it was good to welcome a number of new faces to an ATTA event. Not that all the new faces were masters, with a couple of young triathletes also joining the ranks. Welcome to you all, and hopefully you suffered just enough to want to come back and do it again. Also returning to an ATTA on-road event, and definitely not in the master's category, was Jai Hindley whose friendly demeanour across the morning netted him even more admirers.

Jai was our first man off, returning a bit over 53 minutes later with a PB based on the time he set as a junior back in 2010. Conversation around those still to start was that maybe that was beatable, which Jarred Anderson proved was the case shaving 80 seconds of his previous best with an exceptional ride. He also modestly acknowledged that this was the start of Jai's season but a wonderful performance by him regardless. Marion Mundt was the fastest female, Matheos Venetis topped the standards podium, Sean Ralph the fastest man on a road bike, and Irina Baimatova the fastest female in the female road category. There is the possibility that Luke Durbridge just might have had an impact on proceedings, but he was busy enjoying the recent arrival of their new baby. Congratulations to the parents.

ATTA is not just about those fast people demonstrating athletic ability. Standing at the start and finish line it was wonderful to see so many people satisfied with their morning's work, and realising that maybe there is just that little bit more in the tank to come back and do a little better next time. And to continue to be motivated by the likes of Jai and Jarred.

Kim Van Amerongen and David Equid took care of sorting out start lists etc. with Kim looking after timing on the day (with Mouse and David in the background). Troy Wainwright and Kylie were up early setting up the course, with Sue Challen looking after BWTM duties. Gwyn Williams was her usual highly efficient self, taking care of the desk. Summer Roberts and Paula Machado had a busy morning making sure riders safely negotiated the roundabout, with Kylie jumping in to make sure Jai didn't need to slow down too much on his way home (taking advantage of the opportunity to get some photos of a former MCC cyclist). Eric Semillion made sure everybody safely reached the turnaround point. John Healy had the pleasure of being your starter and race focal point, enjoying the opportunity to welcome new faces, as well as many returning ones.

Safety is always one of our prime concerns. Whilst nobody knowingly contravened any road rules there were some cases of potentially dangerous behaviour, notably one rider overtaking a car which had slowed down to not endanger one of our riders, and a number of cases of riders three abreast transiting to and from the start/finish. Upsetting the locals does nothing for the longevity of cycling events in WA.

We are back at Chidlow in a couple of weeks' time to complete four laps of the Chidlow C course.
